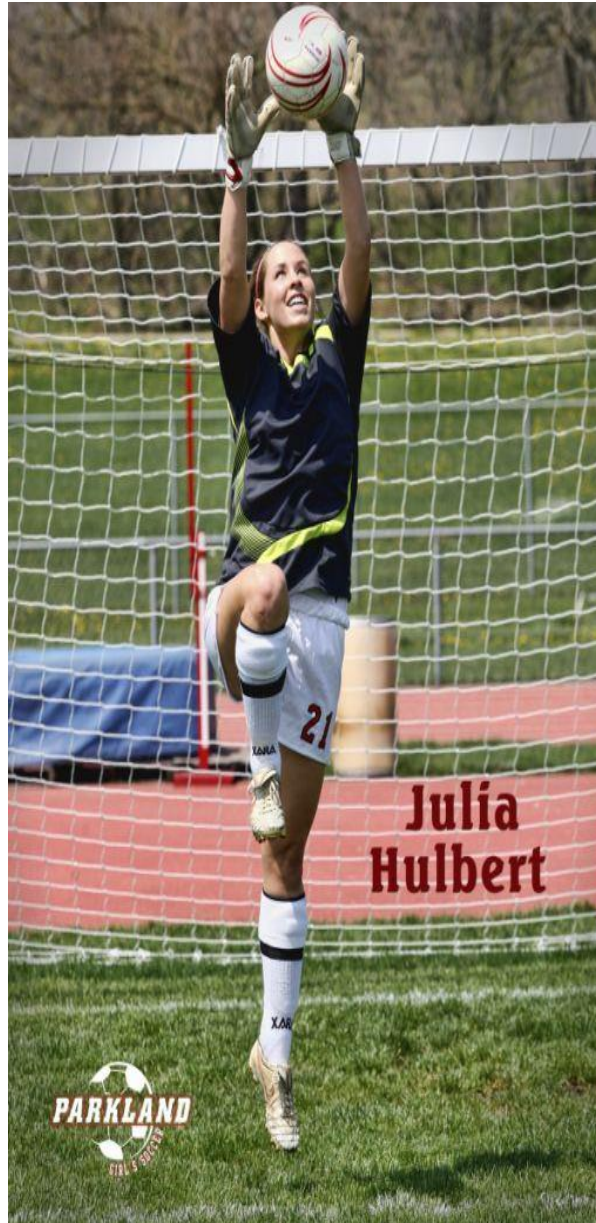

PHS Staff Coach's along with some of the top scorers & Players in PHS history, will focus on proper footwork enabling a more consistent and stronger strike on the ball. Receiving the ball with your back to goal and making better tactical runs will be some of the areas they will address at camp.

Every player needs to become a more attacking and dangerous player so whether you are a **forward, midfielder or back**, you will greatly benefit from this instruction.

Campers will have very specific technical skills training that they will be able to go home and practice on their own to improve.

A tremendous amount of repetition in front of a goal will excite the players as the thrill of scoring is as great in practice as it is in games. Speaking of games, there are daily games where the players need to execute that days learned technique and of course...the final games on Thursday, can they beat the goalkeepers?!

Players should be dressed in soccer attire, shorts, shirt, spikes, shinguards, gloves (if keeper). Players should bring a ball and water bottle. If an actual bottle, please have their name on it and on their ball.

Camp is held at Parkland High School on the Soccer Turf Field. Please arrive on Monday by 5:45pm.
